We're Back and Still Here!

After a long pause for the integration with Old Dominion University, The Safety Net is back. EH&S hasn't stopped and we would like to take this opportunity to let our co-workers know what has changed since the integration, what hasn't changed, and what is on the horizon.

What's Changed

- The institution is now "Macon and Joan Brock Virginia Health Sciences at Old Dominion University", abbreviated "VHS."
- Respiratory Protection Program
 - Now utilizes RedCap to send automated compliance messages to those who have not completed their fit tests, are nearing renewal, or whose fit tests have expired
 - Medical Clearances are only valid for 30 days.
 - Has its own dedicated program administrator, Kristi Olivar.
- New Occupational Safety Officer, Genette Stump.
- Chemical Safety Data Sheets (SDS) are now available through SciShield. All VHS employees can access the SDS module here: <u>https://evms.scishield.com/raft/</u> <u>research_tools/SDS</u>

What's Hasn't Changed

- **Research**: Each campus maintains its own, separate IBC, IACUC, Radiation Safety, and Chemical & Environmental Safety Committees. If the work will be done on the medical campus, the VHS committee will do the project reviews
- Separate EH&S offices. VHS EH&S is still located in Lewis Hall 2132/2142.
- VHS EH&S conducts inspections and a Site Visits on VHS and Medical Group facilities.
- Each campus maintains its own Radioactive Materials License.
- Chemical Inventories are still completed through SciShield.
- Safety Trainings are still campus specific.
- Respiratory Protection Program covers only VHS Medical Campus personnel.

What's Hasn't Changed

- Initial **Chemical Hygiene Plan** training will transition to online instruction.
- Radiation Safety Manual and Respiratory Protection Program updates.
- Updated Hazard Communication Plan and training.

Emergency Cold Storage

Environmental Health & Safety (EH&S) has multiple freezers available when emergencies occur. Currently there are four -80° freezers, one -20° freezer, and a liquid nitrogen dewar available for emergency cold storage. All EH&S freezers have <u>Minus80 Monitoring</u>.

To be allowed access to the Emergency Freezers, you must first contact EH&S through phone, email, or in person at the EH&S Office (in Lewis Hall 2132) during regular working hours. For after-hours and weekends, call the Emergency Freezer Pager. The procedures for using the Freezer Pagers are:

- 1. Dial (757) 415-0014
- 2. After the beep, punch in the phone number of the phone you are using plus "#"
- 3. Hang up, and EH&S will call you back
